

## Careers Programme

Our careers programme offers a range of opportunities for students to access information and guidance to help inform future plans and options and support confidence with GCSE and other exam choices.

In a changing world it is becoming increasingly important that students are aware of their options for the future and have access to support from staff, employers and educational providers to make the best possible decisions for their future.

Our careers programme is taught in line with the Careers Access Policy

All pupils in years 8 to 13 are entitled:

- to find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point;
- to hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships – through options events, assemblies and group discussions and taster events;
- to understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

For pupils of compulsory school age these encounters are mandatory and there will be a minimum of two encounters for year 8 to 9 pupils and two encounters for year 10 to 11 pupils. For pupils in year 12 to 13, particularly those that have not yet decided on their next steps, there are two more provider encounters available during this period, which are optional for pupils to attend.
