

First task:

List the top five time periods you would like to visit for a day?

E.g. Roman times, Medieval times, World War 2 etc.

Second task:

Write a short story that has you travelling back in time to one of your selected times. An important part of any story is putting conflict into it (an issue or problem the hero must either solve or overcome). Therefore in your story something dangerous should happen. This should be appropriate for the time period.

Eg. If visiting WW2 London then your character might get caught up in an air raid.

Third task:

Imagine someone coming from the past into our time. Again write a short story, but this time about a character from history coming to present times.

Extension task:

Imagine the person from history that you wrote about in the third task is giving a news interview about being in this time. Write a script for this interview.

The script should be laid out in the following way;

Interviewer: Ladies and gentlemen please welcome Zog the caveman. Zog, please tell us how you have found modern day Britain?

Zog: Ug.

Interviewer: Fascinating...
